MLI @ UCC, Cork

UCC was established in 1845 as one of the three Queen's Colleges in Cork, Belfast and Galway, although its academic tradition can be traced as far back as St Finbarr the founder of a monastery and school of learning on the same site. The modern 44 acre campus is noted for its well-wooded grounds and the Gothic revival-style Main Quadrangle buildings, modeled on a typical Oxford College.

MLI @ NCI, Dublin

The latest addition to our Dublin centre's the National College of Ireland is ideally located in the heart of Dublin city centre. The college is a mere 10 minute walk from O'Connell Street and its state-of-the-art campus offers excellent facilities including the restaurant and student accommodation.
