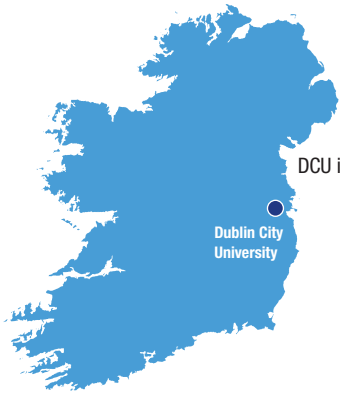
Dublin City University (DCU)

Dublin City University (abbreviated as DCU) (Irish: Ollscoil Chathair Bhaile Átha Cliath) is a university situated on the Northside of Dublin in Ireland. Created as the National Institute for Higher Education, Dublin, it enrolled its first students in 1980.

DCU is a young, dynamic and ambitious university with a distinctive mission to transform lives and societies through education, research and innovation. In the last nine years, DCU has twice been named Sunday Times 'University of the Year'.
